In this musical thriller set in London, a respected barber, loving husband and father is exiled and wrongfully imprisoned in Australia for 15 years. He returns to London, assuming the name Sweeney Todd, to discover his wife dead and his daughter the ward of the very man who imprisoned him. Todd enlists his former landlady and local pie shop owner Mrs. Lovett to once again set up his shop above her failing business with only one mission...revenge. Director Landon Shaw is anxious to share what he calls, "a truly unique and beautiful love story" with ACT II audiences.
